


MINING





% OF POWER CONSUMED








FEDERAL DEFICIT REDUCTION IS ACCELERATING

SUCESSFUL FISCAL AGREEMENT WITH PROVINCES


FISCAL SURPLLUS BY PROVINCE


AR\$ MULTILATERAL EXCHANGE RATE INDEX*

FOUR-QUARTER AVERAGE, FIXED ASSETS AS % OF GDP




